



Behavioral Threat Assessment for School Officials Training Announcement

The Minnesota School Safety Center is hosting a free, 1-day behavioral threat assessment training for school officials in all six regions of the state.

The Basic Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course (B-TERC) is part of the National Threat Evaluation and Reporting program from the Department of Homeland Security. Participants are equipped with the tools to identify and report warning signs or observable behaviors that may concern others as well as recognize intervention strategies to move individuals off a pathway to violence.


Cost of training: Free (travel accommodations and food are not provided).
